- The receiving institution will send its decision within DK ALBORG01: 6-8 weeks
 CZ BRN001: Brno University of Technology sends notification on admission automatically within 5 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution

DK ALBORG01: only upon request from the student in question and **CZ BRNO01:** Brno University of Technology sends transcripts approximately within 5 weeks after the examinations period after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

4. Termination of the agreement

DK ALBORG01: [In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.]

CZ BRNO01: If one or both parties wish to terminate the agreement a notice period of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

In the event that notice of termination of the agreement is given, students who have already been selected and accepted for the exchange programme may still participate. Notwithstanding the termination of the agreement, each institution agrees that it will continue to fulfil its responsibilities to Exchange Students already registered at their institution until the completion of their particular exchange period.
