CZ BRNO01

Additional requirements for incoming students: basic knowledge of technical university physics, mathematics and theoretical electrical engineering – minimal grade 6/10.

P LISBOA05

- The recommended language of instruction level can be discuss on a "case to case" basis, with each Erasmus Coordinator and depending on the chosen curriculum; most of classes are conducted in Portuguese, but some classes can be offered in English.
- The Portuguese language course take at ISEL P LISBOA05 might be included in the student learning agreement but its marks will be not part of the regular transcript of records. An additional document will be provided including mark, language level and ECTs credits;
- ISEL have the infrastructure to welcome students or staff with disabilities, in same cases.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
