- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
  - TU Wien will send its invitation letter within 4 weeks after the official nomination of the candidate by the home institution.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
  - Students can download and print out their official Transcript of Records from "TU Wien Information Services" (TISS) 5 weeks after the exam by the earliest.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
