D. Additional requirements

N HALDENO2:

• The International Office organises welcome activities for all exchange students including an orientation week and a buddy scheme.

- Students with disabilities are welcome to apply. The necessary arrangements need to be discussed in advance.
- Norwegian language course is offered for incoming students during the semesters.

CZ BRN001:

- Exchange students can request to do a final degree project/Master's thesis at FCE. A student who wants to carry out a project must contact International Office of FCE to find out a topic. A student has to make the arrangement with an appropriate professor.
- · Services for incoming students:
 - Welcome Week is organized for international students each semester where students get information about the university in general, administrative issues, student activities, language course, and other services. The integration of incoming students is fostered also in the areas of education and social life.
 - Czech language course is offered for incoming students during the semesters.
- Faculty of Civil Engineering of BUT has barrier free access; students on wheelchair can attend
 courses at the faculty. We can guarantee individual approach to such a student. Acceptance
 and further arrangements need to be agreed in advance.

The receiving institution will send its decision on admission within 5 weeks.

The host university will issue a Transcript of Records no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished.

The host university will report the transcript of records from each visiting student to the home university using the English language.

Termination of the agreement

If one or both parties wish to terminate the agreement a notice period of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

In the event that notice of termination of the agreement is given, students who have already been selected and accepted for the exchange programme may still participate. Notwithstanding the termination of the agreement, each institution agrees that it will continue to fulfil its responsibilities to Exchange Students already registered at their institution until the completion of their particular exchange period.
